





## ✓✓ Unit 6A

1. **Habits** /'hæb.ɪt/ (noun): something that you do often and regularly, sometimes without knowing that you are doing it:  
**E.g.:** I always buy the same brand of toothpaste out of (= because of) habit.
2. **Traditional** / trə'dɪʃənəl/ (adjective): being part of the traditions of a country  
**E.g.:** Kabab is a traditional Iranian food.
3. **Valuable** / væl.jə.bəl/ (adjective): worth a lot of money:  
**E.g.:** These antiques are extremely valuable.
4. **Desert** / dez.ə't/ (noun): an area,  
  
often covered with sand or rocks, where there is very little rain and not many plants:  
**E.g.:** They were lost in the desert for nine days.
5. **Poor** pɔr/ (adjective): Having very little money  
OPP Rich  
**E.g.:** They are poor they can't go to the restaurant.
6. **Sweet** / swi:t/ (adjective): Having a taste like sugar  
**E.g.:** This tea is too sweet.
7. **Silver** /'sɪl.və/ (noun): a chemical element that is a valuable shiny, white metal, used for making cutlery (= knives, spoons, etc.), jewellery, coins, and decorative objects:  
**E.g.:** Great Britain won (a) silver/a silver medal in the javelin.  


8. **Ring** / rɪŋ/ (noun): A piece of jewelry that you wear on your fingers.  
**E.g.:** A diamond ring.
9. **Palace** / pæl.ɪs/ a large house that is the official home of a king, queen, or other person of high social rank:  
**E.g.:** Buckingham Palace is open to the public.  

10. **Surprise** / sər'praɪz/ (noun): An unexpected or unusual event SYN Shock  
**E.g.:** What a surprise to find you here!
11. **Comfortable** / 'kʌmfətəbəl/ (adjective): Making you feel physically relaxed  
**E.g.:** The bed isn't comfortable to lie down.
12. **Strange** / streɪndʒ/ (adjective): Unusual or surprising, SYN odd  
**E.g.:** Strange noises.
13. **Bottle** / eepɪŋg liquids in, usually made of plastic or glass  
**E.g.:** An empty bottle.
14. **Coins** /kɔɪn/ (noun): a small, round piece of metal, usually silver or copper coloured, that is used as money:  
**E.g.:** gold coins  

15. **Clever** / 'klev.ə/ (adjective): having or showing the ability to learn and understand things quickly and easily:  
**E.g.:** Judy has never been very clever, but she tries hard.

16. **In return** / ɪnˈtʁɪːn/ (idiom): as an exchange for something:  
**E.g.:** The farmer offered us food in return for our work.

## ✓✓ Unit 6B

1. **Thumb** / θʌm/ (noun): the part of your hand that is like a thick short finger and helps you to hold things  
**E.g.:** She held the coin between finger and thumb.
2. **Floor** / flɔːr/ (noun): The flat surface that you stand on inside a building  
**E.g.:** We are on 2nd floor.
3. **Psychologist** / saɪˈkɒlədʒɪst/ (noun): Someone who is trained in psychology  
**E.g.:** She works as an educational psychologist in Tehran.
4. **Resolution** / rezəˈluːʃən/ (noun): The ability of a device to show an image clearly and with a lot of detail  
**E.g.:** Computer screens with high resolutions.
5. **Festive** / fes.tɪv/ (adjective): having or producing happy and enjoyable feelings suitable for a festival or other special occasion:  
**E.g.:** The hall looked very festive with its Christmas tree.
6. **In the middle of** (noun): In center part of something  
**E.g.:** He was standing in the middle of the room.
7. **Enjoy** / ɪnˈdʒɔɪ/ (verb): To get pleasure from something  
**E.g.:** Sandra enjoys her job in the city.
8. **Roommate** / ˈruːm meɪt/ (noun): Someone who you share a room with  
**E.g.:** Sarah is my roommate.
9. **Silence** / saɪləns/ (noun): Complete absence of sound or noise  
**E.g.:** The teacher asked for silence.
10. **Ride** /raɪd/ (noun): a journey on a horse or bicycle, or in a vehicle:  
**E.g.:** It's a short bus ride to the airport.





## ✓✓ Unit 6C

1. **Accordion** / ə'kɔːr.di.ən/ (noun): a box-shaped musical instrument consisting of a folded central part with a keyboard, played by pushing the two ends towards each other



2. **Reggae** / 'regeɪ/ (noun): A kind of popular music from Jamaica  
**E.g.:** People of Jamaica are interested in Reggae music.

3. **Public transportation** / pʌb.lɪk træn.spɔː'teɪ.ʃən/ (noun): a system of vehicles such as buses and trains that operate at regular times on fixed routes and are used by the public:  
**E.g.:** Greater investment in public transportation would keep more cars off the roads.

4. **Particular** / pər'tɪkjələɪ/ (adjective): Special  
**E.g.:** A particular type of food.

5. **Yacht** / jɑ:t/ (noun): a boat with sails and sometimes an engine, used for either racing or travelling on for pleasure:  
**E.g.:** a luxury yacht



6. **Fantastic** / fəntəstɪk/ (adjective): Extremely good, attractive, enjoyable  
**E.g.:** You look fantastic!

7. **Perform** /pə'fɔːrm/ (verb): to do an action or piece of work:  
**E.g.:** Computers can perform a variety of tasks.

8. **Folk** / fəʊk/ (noun) modern music and songs that are written in a style similar to that of traditional music:  
**E.g.:** I enjoy listening to folk (music).
