

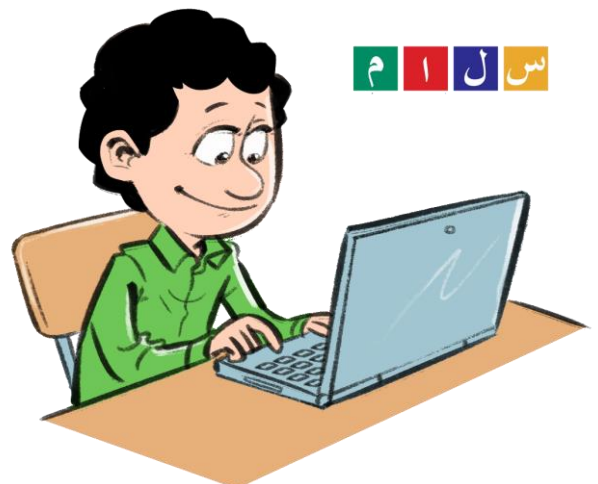


## ✓✓ Unit 9A

1. **Vegetarians** /vedʒə'terijən/ (noun): A person who does not eat meat  
**E.g.:** My brother is a vegetarian.
2. **Delicious** //dɪ'lɪʃəs/ (adjective): Very good taste  
**E.g.:** Pasta is delicious.
3. **Addicted** /ə'dɪk.tɪd/ (adjective): unable to stop taking drugs, or doing something as a habit:  
**E.g.:** I am addicted to chocolate.
4. **Diet** / daɪət/ (noun): A way of eating in which you eat less than usual to lose weight, or to improve your health.  
**E.g.:** Jack is fat, he needs to go on a diet.
5. **Bored** / bɔrd/ (adjective): tired because you do not think something is interesting, or because you have nothing to do  
**E.g.:** I am bored with my job.
6. **Waste** / weɪst/ (verb): to use too much of something or use something badly when there is a limited amount of it:  
**E.g.:** You waste a lot of water by taking a bath instead of a shower.
7. **Herb** /æ:b/ (noun): a type of plant whose leaves are used in cooking to give flavour to particular dishes or in making medicine:  
**E.g.:** Basil, oregano, thyme, and rosemary are all herbs.
8. **Ingredient** / m'grɪdiənt/ (noun): One of the foods that you use to make a particular food or dish  
**E.g.:** Combine all the ingredients in a large bowl.

9. **Pineapple** / paɪnæpəl/ (noun): A large yellow- brown tropical fruit or its sweet juicy flesh  
**E.g.:** Pineapple is so delicious.
10. **Refrigerator** //rɪ'frɪdʒəreɪtər/ (noun): An electrical equipment, like a cupboard, used for keeping food and drink cool SYN Fridge  
**E.g.:** Beside the door there was a big refrigerator.
11. **Lettuce** / 'letɪs/ (noun): A round vegetable with thin green leaves eaten raw 44  
**E.g.:** A salad made with crisp lettuce.
12. **Cranberry** /'kræn.ber.i/ (noun): a small, round, red fruit with a sour taste





## ✓✓ Unit 9B

- Fresh** /frefʃ/ (adjective): Not frozen  
**E.g.:** Drink fresh coffee.
- Laundry** /ləndri/ (noun): Clothes that you should wash them  
**E.g.:** She did the laundry and hung it to dry.
- Detergent** /dɪtɜrdʒənt/ (noun): A liquid or powder used for washing clothes, dishes  
**E.g.:** Wash your clothes with Pak detergent.
- Float** /flot/ (verb): To stay or move on water without sinking  
**E.g.:** The dead person was floating on the water.
- Rugs** /rʌg/ (noun): A piece of thick cloth or wool that covers part of a floor, used as a decoration  
**E.g.:** A large circular rug.
- Contain** /kən'teɪn/ (verb): If something such as a box contains something, that thing is inside of it  
**E.g.:** The film contains many scary scenes.
- Ritual** /'rɪtʃuəl/ (noun): A social or religious ceremony  
**E.g.:** Rituals are very important in our lives.
- Suicide** /'su:əsɪd/ (noun): The act of killing yourself  
**E.g.:** He committed suicide because of depression.
- Spoonful** /'spu:nfʊl/ (noun): The amount that a spoon can have  
**E.g.:** Two-spoonful of sugar, please.

## ✓✓ Unit 9C

- Population** /pəpjə'leɪʃən/ (noun): The number of people living in a place  
**E.g.:** India has a population of one billion.
- Contestant** /kən'testənt/ (noun): Someone who take part in a competition.  
**E.g.:** There are six contestants in the race.
- Compare** /kəm'per/ (verb): To consider two or more things or people, in order to show how they are similar or different  
**E.g.:** Don't compare your abilities to others.
- Sore loser** (noun): a person who becomes very upset or angry when he or she loses a game, contest, etc.
- Cheat** /tʃi:t/ (verb): to behave in a dishonest way in order to get what you want:  
**E.g.:** He cheats at cards.
- Affair** /ə'fer/ (noun): a situation or subject that is being dealt with or considered:  
**E.g.:** She organizes her financial affairs very efficiently.
- Expert** /'ekspɜ:rt/ (noun): Someone who knows a lot about something  
**E.g.:** He's a computer expert.
- Competition** /kəmpe'tɪʃən/ (noun): A situation in which people try to be more successful than other people  
**E.g.:** There is a competition at school.
