- Listen** /'lɪsn/ (verb): To pay attention to someone or something to hear what they say.
E.g.: I like to listen to music.
- Repeat** /rɪ'pit/ (verb): To say, tell, or do something again
E.g.: She repeats the question.
- Nice to meet you:** Happy to see you
E.g.: I am Henry. Nice to meet you.
- Pair** /peər/ (noun): plural pairs - Two things or two people
E.g.: My dad bought me a pair of shoes.
- Practice** /'præktɪs/ (verb): To do something again and again to become better at it.
E.g.: To be a good musician, practice a lot.
- Write** /'raɪt/ (verb): To form letters or numbers with a pen, pencil, etc.
E.g.: Children learning to read and write.
- Nice** /naɪs/ (adjective): Good or enjoyable
E.g.: They have a very nice house.
- Meet** /mit/ (verb): See somebody in a place
E.g.: Meet me at 8.00.



✓✓ Unit 1B

- Country** /'kʌntri/ (noun): An area of land that is controlled by its own government
E.g.: Iran is a beautiful country.
- Check** /tʃek/ (verb): To find something
E.g.: Check the dictionary to find the meaning.
- Nationality** /næʃə'næləti/ (noun): A group of people who have the same language, and live together in a country
E.g.: I am from Iran and my nationality is Iranian.
- Where is she from?** Used to say from which city or country she comes from.
E.g.: Where is she from? She is from Iran.
- Chart** /'tʃɑ:t/ (noun): Information in the form of a table, diagram
E.g.: Write the words in the chart
- Question** /'kwestʃən/ (noun): A sentence that asks for information
E.g.: Can I ask you some questions?
- Hear** /'hiər/ (verb): To receive sound with ears.
E.g.: Can you hear the noise?

1. **Spell** /spel/ (verb): To name or write the letters of a word in order.
E.g.: How do you spell 'car'? - It is C_A_R
2. **Circle** /'sərkəl/ (noun): A round shape
E.g.: Circle the correct answer.
3. **Watch** /wətʃ/ (verb): To look closely or carefully.
E.g.: We watch movie every night.
4. **Reservation** /rəzər'veiʃən/ (noun): An arrangement to have a room, table, or seat at a later time
E.g.: I have a hotel reservation.
5. **Artist** /'ɑ:tɪst \$ 'a:r-/ (noun): someone who produces art
E.g.: Mozart was an artist. He played piano.
6. **Journalist** /'dʒɜ:nəl-ɪst \$ -ɜ:r-/ (noun): someone who writes news reports for newspapers, magazines, television, or radio → reporter
E.g.: He is a journalist of Hamshahry newspaper.
7. **Vacation** /və'keiʃən \$ veɪ-/ (noun): a holiday, or time spent not working
E.g.: We're planning a vacation in Europe.

8. **Surname** /'sɜ:nəm \$ 'sɜ:r-/ (noun): the name that you share with your parents - Familyname
E.g.: My name is Ali and my surname is Ahmadi.
9. **Booking** /'bʊkɪŋ/ (Verb): reserving a hotel or place to stay
E.g.: I made a booking for two double rooms.

10. **Favorite** /'feɪvərət/ (adjective): something you like or want it a lot.
E.g.: my favorite food is pasta.
