1. **Lake** /leɪk/ (noun): A large area of water that is surrounded by land

E.g.: Oromia lake doesn't have water.

2. **Destination** / 'destə'neɪʃən/ (noun): the place that someone or something is going to

E.g.: Maui is a popular tourist destination.

3. **Peak** / pi:k/ (noun): the sharply pointed top of a mountain

E.g.: Mount McKinley is Alaska's highest peak.

4. **Boat** /boot/ (noun): A small, open vehicle for traveling on water

E.g.: We travel by a boat.

5. **Shore** / ʃɔ: / \$ ʃɔ:r/ (noun): the land along the edge of a large area of water such as an ocean or lake

E.g.: We could see a boat about a mile from shore.

6. **Wonderful** //'wʌndərfəl/ (adjective):

Excellent or amazing.

E.g.: Mona Liza is a wonderful painting.

7. **Elevator** //'eləveɪtər/ (noun): A machine that takes people and goods from one level to another in a building **SYN** Lift

E.g.: We have to take the elevator to go to the 4th floor.

8. **Bathtub** / 'ba:θtʌb/ (noun): a long large container that you fill with water and sit or lie in to wash yourself **SYN** bath



9. **Parking lot** (noun): an open area for cars to park **SYN** car park

10. **Monster** / 'ma:nstər/ (noun): an imaginary or ancient creature that is large, ugly, and frightening

E.g.: Only a monster could kill all those men.

1. **Detective** / dɪ'tektɪv/ (noun): a police officer whose job is to discover information about crimes and catch criminals

E.g.: She hired a detective to find out if her husband was having an affair.

2. **Meeting** /'mɪtɪŋ/ (noun): An event at which people meet to discuss and decide things

E.g.: We're having a meeting next week to discuss the matter.

3. **Avenue** / 'ævənu:/ (noun): a road or broad path between two rows of trees, especially one leading to a big house.

E.g.: a tree-lined avenue

4. **Robbery** / 'rʌbəri/ (adjective): looking or feeling like rubber

E.g.: rubbery eggs

5. **Jewelry** / 'dʒu:əlri / (noun): small things that you wear for decoration, such as rings or necklaces.

E.g.: She wears a lot of gold jewelry.
