




✓✓ Unit 4A

- Husband** /'hʌzbənd/ (noun): the man that a woman is married to
E.g.: Have you met my husband Roy?
- Babysitter** /'beɪbɪ,sɪt/ (noun): a person who looks after a child or children while the parents are out.
E.g.: I need a babysitter to take care of my child.
- Cute**: /kju:t/ (adjective): very pretty or attractive
E.g.: The baby's so cute.
- Parent** /peərənt/ (noun): the father or mother of a person or animal
E.g.: Melissa's spending the weekend at her parents' house.
- Children** /'tʃɪldrən/ (noun): a son or daughter of any age
E.g.: The hotel is ideal for families with young children.

- Remember** /rɪ'membə/ (verb): to keep in the memory.
E.g.: I can't remember my teacher's name.
- Married** /'mærɪd/ (verb): having a husband or a wife
E.g.: Are you married or single?

1. **perfect** /'kʌntri/ (adjective): completely enjoyable; most excellent.
E.g.: It is a perfect day for a picnic.
2. **logo** / 'ləʊgəʊ / (noun): a company's name, or symbol.
3. **Nationality** /næʃə'næləti/ (noun): A group of people who have the same language, and live together in a country
E.g.: I am from Iran and my nationality is Iranian.
4. **Opinion** / ə'pɪnjən/ (noun): your ideas about a subject
E.g.: What is your opinion of John?
5. **Slow** / sləʊ \$ sloʊ / (adjective): not moving or happening quickly
E.g.: Take a few deep, slow breaths.
6. **Ugly** / 'ʌgli/ (adjective): not attractive or beautiful
E.g.: a very ugly man
7. **Expensive** / ɪk'spensɪv/ (adjective): costing a lot of money **OPP cheap**
E.g.: Photography is an expensive hobby.
8. **Famous** /feɪməs/ (adjective): Liked by many people
E.g.: Selena Gomez is a famous singer.
9. **Tomorrow** /tə'marəʊ/ (adverb): The day after today
E.g.: We meet each other tomorrow.
10. **Watch** (noun): a small device for measuring and showing the time, often worn on the wrist.

11. **Village** /tə'marəʊ/ (noun): a small town or community, often in the country.
E.g.: Abyaneh is a great village in Isfahan.
12. **Host** / həʊst/ (noun): a person who entertains guests.
E.g.: Our host greeted us at the door.
