1. **Important** /ɪm'pɔːr.tənt/ (adjective): necessary
E.g.: Eating breakfast is important.
2. **Meal** /mi:l/ (noun): The time when you eat a food.
E.g. He eats three full meals a day.
3. **Scientist** / 'saɪən.tɪst/ (noun): a person who works in some branch of science.
E.g.: Maryam Mirzakhani was a great scientist.
4. **During** /'dʊrɪŋ/ (Preposition): Throughout the entire time of (an event, period, occurrence, etc.)
E.g.: She swims every day during the summer.

9. **Traditional** /trə'dɪʃənəl/ (Adjective): being part of the traditions of a country or group of people
E.g.: Kebab is a traditional food.
10. **Favorite** /'mægəzi:n/ (noun): /'feɪvrət/ (adjective): A person or a thing that is liked more than others.
E.g.: My favorite food is Pizza.

11. **Vegetable** /'vedʒ.tə.bəl/ (noun): a plant or part of a plant, such as carrots, beans, or lettuce, that is used for food.
E.g.: The potato is the most popular vegetable

5. **Hungry** /'hʌŋ.gri/ (adjective): when you need to eat something you are hungry
E.g.: I'm hungry because I didn't eat breakfast this morning.
6. **Extra** /'ek.strə/ (Adjective): when you need another one of something.
E.g.: I have a towel but I need an extra towel to dry my hair.



7. **Croissant** /'krwasɔ̃/ (noun): A type of roll that has a curved shape and that is usually eaten at breakfast.
E.g.: I like to have croissant with chocolate for my breakfast.



8. **Toast** /'təʊst/ (noun): Bread that has been sliced and browned in an oven or toaster.
E.g.: I have toast with butter on it for breakfast.

12. **Muffin** /'mʌf.ɪn/ (noun): a small sweet cake that often has fruit inside it:

1. **Flight** /flaɪt/ (noun): a journey in an aircraft
E.g.: My flight was cancelled.
2. **Restroom** /'rest.ru:m/ (noun): toilets



3. **Arrive** /ə'raɪv/ (verb): To come to or reach a place after traveling, being sent, etc.
E.g.: He arrived home at six o'clock.

4. **Meat** /mi:t/ (noun): the flesh of animals and birds eaten as food
E.g.: red/white meat



5. **Airport** /'erpoʊt/ (noun): A place where planes take off and land, with buildings for passengers to wait in → airfield
E.g.: The plane lands at Mehrabad Airport.

6. **Witch** /wɪtʃ/ (noun): A woman who is believed to have magic powers.
E.g.: Witches wear black robes and pointed hats.

7. **Vase** /veɪs/ (noun): An open container of glass or pottery that is usually taller than it is



wide. A vase is used as a decoration or to hold cut need 8. flowers.

E.g.: My father bought some

flowers and my mother bring a vase for them.

9. **Ma'am** /mæm/ (noun): To politely speak to a woman who you do not know = Madam
E.g.: May I help you with your luggage, ma'am?

1. **Train** /treɪn/ (noun): a set of several carriages that are connected to each other and pulled along a railway line by an engine



2. **Tired** /taɪrd/ (adjective): feeling that you want to sleep or rest
E.g.: I'm so tired I could sleep for a week.

3. **Hurry** /hʌrɪ/ (verb): to do something or go somewhere more quickly than usual,
E.g.: There's no need to hurry. We've got plenty of time.

4. **Write** /'raɪt/ (verb): To form letters or numbers with a pen, pencil, etc.
E.g.: Children learning to read and write.



5. **Meeting** /miːtɪŋ/ (noun): An event at which people meet to discuss and decide things
E.g.: We're having a meeting next week to discuss the matter.
