- 1. Exciting** /ɪk'saɪtɪŋ/ (adjective): making you feel excited
E.g.: I've got some very exciting news for you.
- 2. Activities** /'æk'tɪvəti/ (noun): things that people do, especially in order to achieve a particular aim
E.g.: leisure activities
- 3. Go shopping** to go to one or more shops to buy things, often for enjoyment
E.g.: The next day, Saturday, we went shopping.
- 4. housework** /'haʊswɜːrk/ (noun): Work (such as cleaning, cooking, or laundry) that is done to keep a house clean.
E.g.: My mom does all the housework.
- 5. Favorite** /'feɪvərət/ (adjective): A person or a thing that is liked more than others
E.g.: My favorite food is Pizza.

- 6. Owl** /aʊl/ (noun): A bird that flies at night and eats small animals
E.g.: Owls are asleep during the day.

- 7. Mountains** /'maʊntɪn \$ 'maʊntən/ (noun): a very high hill
E.g.: Everest mountain



- 8. Tired** /taɪəd \$ taird/ (adjective): feeling that you want to sleep or rest
E.g.:




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- 9. Nearby** /'niəbərɪ \$ 'nɪr- / (adjective): not far away

- 10. Grill** /grɪl/ (noun): A flat metal frame that you put food on to cook over a fire





11. Vacation /veɪ'keɪʃən/ (noun):

A period of time that a person spends away from home, school usually to relax or travel

E.g.: We had a relaxing vacation at the beach.

1. Scene /'si:n/ (noun): part of a play during which there is no change in time or place

2. Cut /kʌt/ (verb): to stop OR to remove parts from a film, book, speech etc, for example because it is too long or might offend people


3. Prefer /pri'fər/ (verb): To like someone or something better than someone or something else
E.g.: I prefer shopping online.

1. Awful /'a:fəl/ (adjective): Very bad or unpleasant

E.g.: The music was awful.

1. Thumb /θʌm/ (noun): the part of your hand that

is shaped like a thick short finger and helps you to hold things



2. Famous /feɪməs/ (adjective): Liked by many people

E.g.: Selena Gomez is a famous singer.

3. Meal /mi:l/ (noun): The time when you eat a food.

E.g.: He eats three full meals a day.
