- Driver's license** (noun):  
an official document or card that says that you are legally allowed to drive SYN driving licence British English
- Difficult** /'dɪfɪkəlt/ (adjective): hard to do or understand OPP easy  
**E.g.:** a difficult job
- Terrible** /'terəbəl/ (adjective): Very bad; not acceptable, causing fear.  
**SYN:** Awful  
**E.g.:** That's a terrible drawing of a cat.
- Instructor** / in'strʌktə \$ -ər / (noun): someone who teaches a sport or practical skill  
**E.g.:** a driving instructor
- Free** / fri: / (adjective): not having something special to do  
**E.g.:** I can come with you I am free.

- Store** /stɔr/ (noun): A store is a large place and sell many things or only one type of thing. → shop  
**E.g.:** At Christmas, the stores are open.
- Order** /'ɔ:rdər/ (verb): to ask for food or a drink in a restaurant, bar etc  
**E.g.** I want to order some food are you hungry?
- Permit** / pə'mit/ (verb): to allow something:  
**E.g.** Smoking is only permitted in the public lounge.

1. **Bull** /'bul/ (noun): a male cow  
**E.g.:** There is a bull picture on the Red bull energy drinks.



2. **Opinion** /ə'pjnjən/ (noun): What one thinks about something or somebody, **SYN** Idea  
**E.g.:** In my opinion, our English teacher is the best teacher in the school.

3. **Terrible** /'terəbəl/ (adjective): Very bad; not acceptable, causing fear.  
**SYN:** Awful  
**E.g.:** That's a terrible drawing of a cat.

4. **Frightened** / 'fraɪ.tənd / (Adjective): afraid or anxious.  
**E.g.:** She gets frightened when he shouts at her.



5. **Concentrate** / 'kə:n.sən.treɪt / (verb): to direct your attention or your effort towards a particular activity, subject, or problem:  
**E.g.:** Come on, concentrate! We don't have all day to do this.

6. **Peaceful** / 'pi:s.fəl / (adjective): without violence or anger
